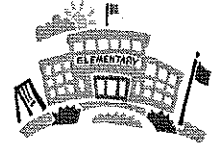

All of us here wish all of you a very safe and happy Winter Break. We look forward to learning and growing and seeing you in 2016!

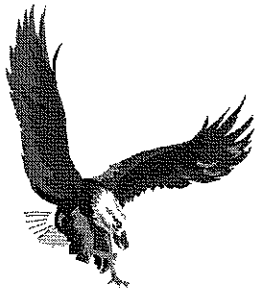

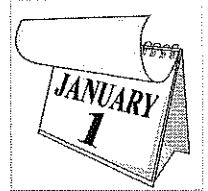

District Calendar for 2016-2019

The Board of Education will vote in December on the new district calendar for 2016-2019. The proposed calendar will use the same general schedule as our current school calendar.

For the 2016-2017 school year, students in grades 1-12 will start on Monday, Aug. 29, with early childhood and kindergarten students beginning on Wednesday, Aug. 31. The last day of school for students Pre-K-11 will be Tuesday, June 13.

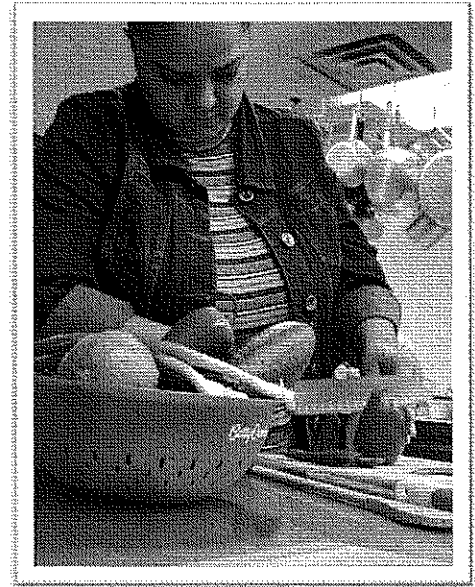

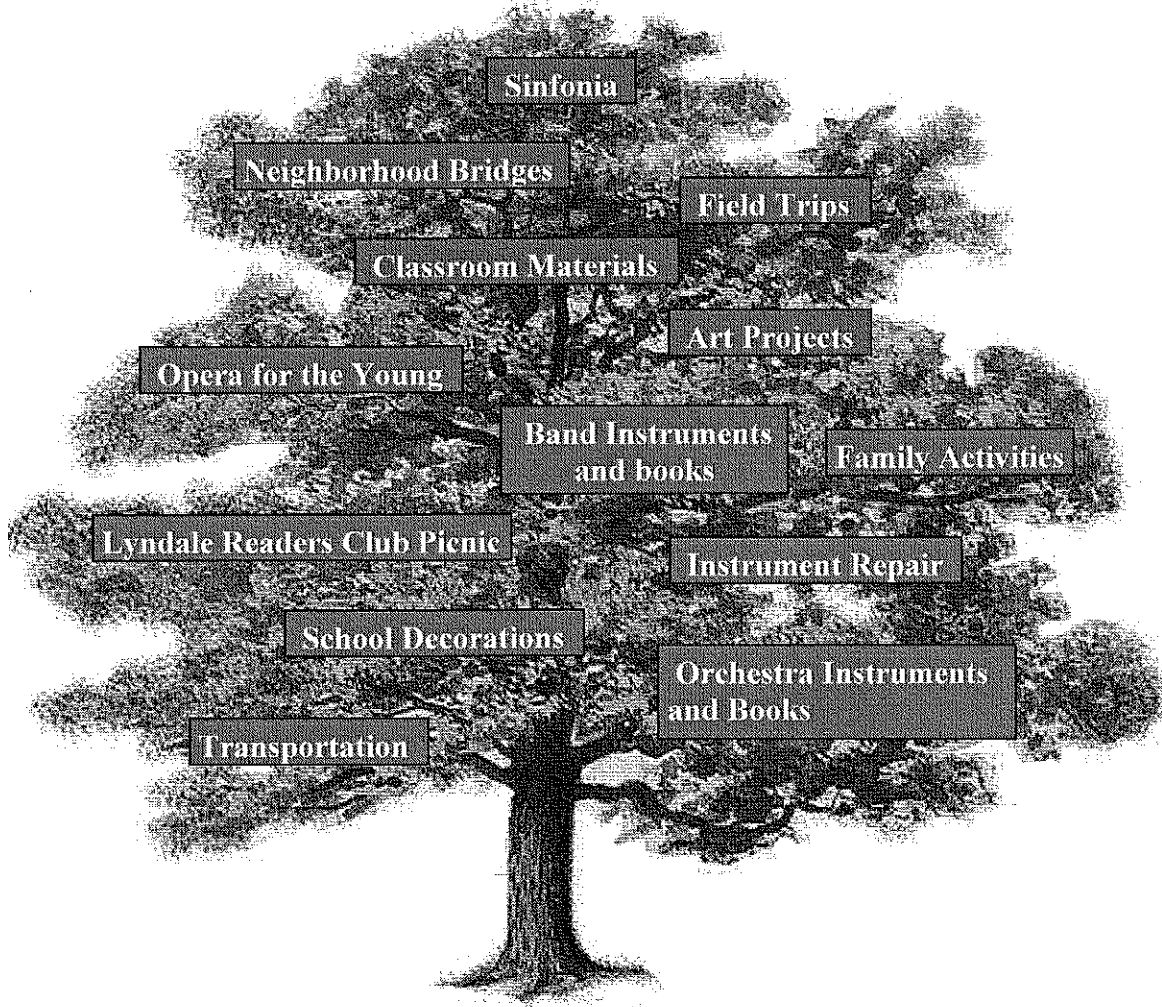
