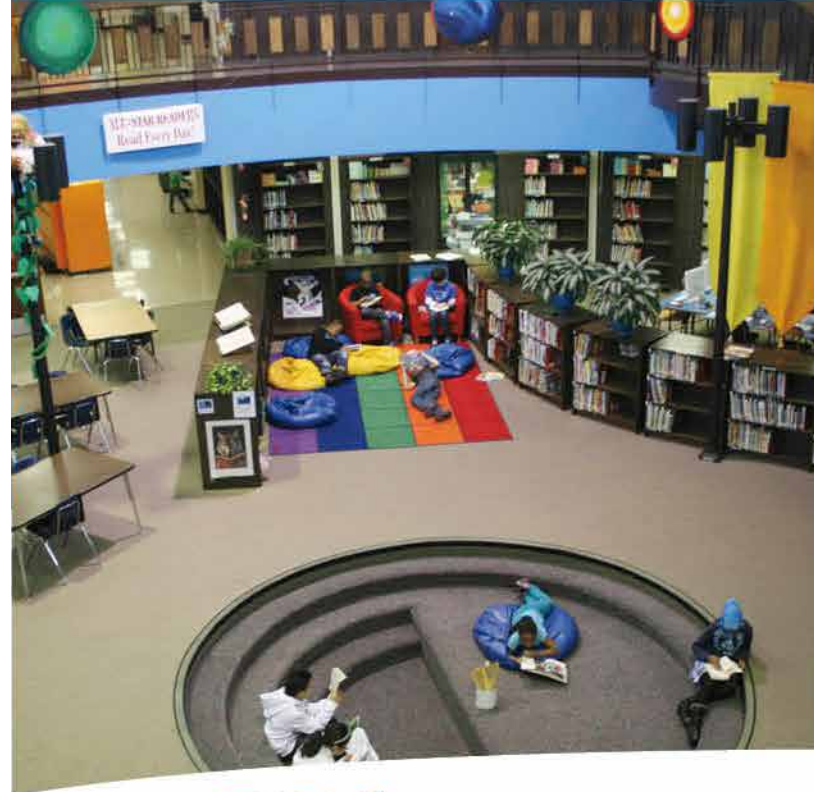

Feeding curious minds

- **Differentiated instruction** means every child is challenged. Lyndale teachers create positive learning environments where all students receive differentiated instruction that meets their individual needs using Guided Reading and the Workshop Model in Mathematics.
- **STEM Fair** is an interactive day displaying the talent and ingenuity of participating students in grades K-5.
- **Monthly Showcases** are performed at school assemblies where classrooms share learning accomplishments with fellow students, teachers and families.

Building friendships & healthy habits

- A daily **walking school bus** and a weekly **Pleasant Pathway** for all students taking the bus gets all kids, staff and families moving, laughing and connecting in the morning.
- **True Food** program introduces the students and staff to new culinary adventures and tastes.
- **Physical Education** programming includes a biking unit, a strong chapter of Girls on the Run, Rope Power and one of the largest groups of students to participate in the family runs at the Twin Cities Marathon weekend.

Creating community

- **Harvest Carnival** kicks off the school year with games, food and raffles.
- **International Night** puts children in charge of guiding families to more awareness of history, foods and cultures.
- **Parent Teacher Organization (PTO)** connects parents, promotes involvement and finds roles for everyone interested.

Exploring the arts

- **Band and Orchestra** (4th & 5th grade)
- **Neighborhood Bridges**, a **Children’s Theater Company** program, brings teaching artists to the second and third grades in ways that inspire and transform literacy.
- **Art partnerships** abound and include Opera for the Young, Sinfonia, Jungle Theater, Highpoint Center for Printmaking and more.
- **Art Extravaganza** showcases the visual and performing talents of all participating students.
