a Feather!

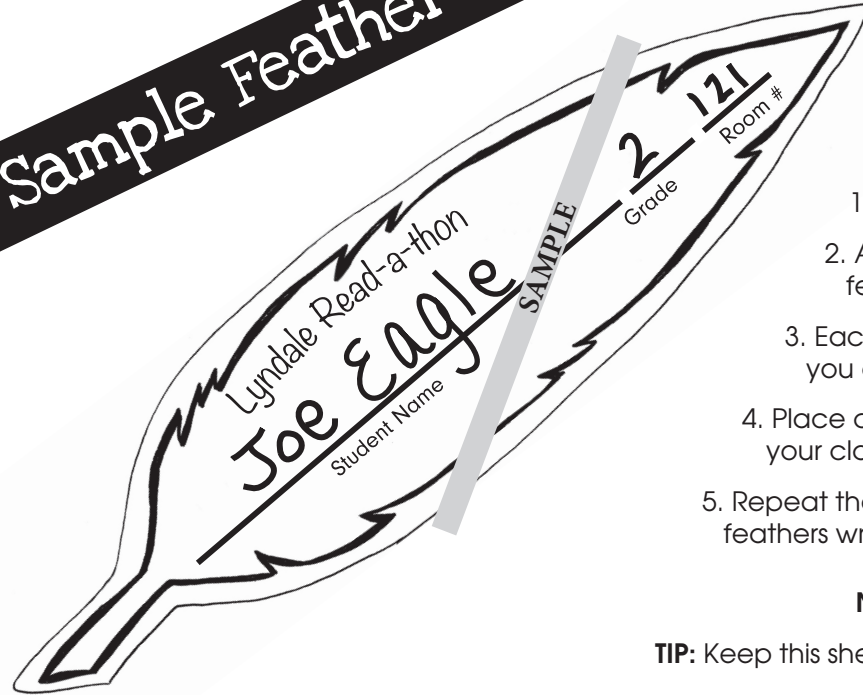
One feather equals:

High-5 = 20 minutes = 2 squares
K = 20 minutes = 2 squares
1st = 20 minutes = 2 squares
2nd = 30 minutes = 3 squares
3rd = 40 minutes = 4 squares
4th = 40 minutes = 4 squares
5th = 40 minutes = 4 squares

How do I track my minutes and fill out a feather?

1. Fill in ONE square for every 10 minutes you read.
2. At the end of each day, add up your minutes and use the feather chart to determine how many feathers you've earned.
3. Each morning in your classroom, fill out the number of feathers you earned the day before.
4. Place completed feathers in the "Feather Return Envelope" found in your classroom.
5. Repeat these steps each day of Read-a-thon & watch the Eagle feathers wrap around the school!

NOTE: Feathers are available in your classroom.
